However, other possible events are being considered such as an auction, a music evening, etc.

At the A B C meeting last Thursday evening some arrangements were made for the **Good Friday** walk of witness in Bakewell: this will follow a different format this year as an experiment and it will be similar to the Christmas procession through the town. The Parish Church clergy and parishioners are planning the event but they will need our help as well to make it an ecumenical occasion.

Pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place 13-19th July.

Next Thursday evening Roger Burkey is arranging a talk for the season of Lent at 7.30pm. "Personal Prayer - Pathway to Joy", part of the series "Exploring the Catholic Church" by Dr M. D'Ambrosio (Professor of Theology). The presentation will be in the Parish Rooms and lasts about 35 minutes. It is part of our Lenten season invitation to do "something extra". All are most welcome to attend and, if you need a lift, please let us know about it.

Parish 100 Club Winners last Sunday were A O'Connor, A Keohane and A Lancashire. Thank you again for supporting the **100 Club** and giving us a few minutes of "parish conversation" after Mass. You will see there are membership renewal reminders in both churches. In April we'll have our parish Reconciliation evening (3rd at 7.00pm), the week of prayer for Christian Unity (6-10th) and we are involved in this. Our preparations for Palm Sunday and Holy Week will begin (13-20th). On 7th April there will be a meeting at 7.30pm to plan the Passion Play in Bakewell (after the unity service). Our Cathedral in Nottingham will host Stainer's **Crucifixion** on Palm Sunday, 13th April. Tickets £7.00 followed by refreshments.
