Archbishop Oscar Romero will be beatified on Saturday, 23rd May 2015 in San Salvador. Some will remember that Mgr Romero, a strong defender of human rights, was assassinated whilst celebrating Mass in San Salvador in March 1980. His murder led to international condemnation.
